#### Reminders:

- Attendance There is a new way to report an absence for your child. You can call 1-833-582-6940, log in to Power School or download the School Messenger app. It is the parent's responsibility to let the school know if their child will not be attending. If you do not report the absence, then the system will call, text and email you regarding your child's absence.
